

The following agreement was obtained from the Huntingdon Archives (Ref Unknown) on the 29th of January 2024. And is between John Marriott and Henry Buffon re Indenture release, it is dated from 1690 the 2nd year of William and Marys reign.

Know all men by these presents that I John Marriott of Upper Dean in the County of Bedford labourer have received before the unsealing and delivery of these presents received and had of and from Henry Buffon of Keyston in the County of Huntingdon labourer the full sum of two and twenty pounds and twelve shillings of good and lawful money of England

Being the consideration money expressed to be paid to me by the said Henry Buffon in one pair of Indentures bearing equal date with these presents and made or expressed to be made between the said John Marriott and Susanna his wife of the one part and the said Henry Buffon of the other part of and from which said sum of two and twenty pounds and twelve shillings so by me received as aforesaid

I the said John Marriott do hereby for myself my heir's executors and administrators acquit release and for ever discharge the said Henry Buffon his heir's executors & administrators and every of them by these present

In witness whereof I the said John Marriott have hereunto set my hand and Seale the Nine and twentieth day of March in the Second year of the Reign of our Sovereigne Lord and Lady William and Mary by the Grace of God of England Scotland France and Ireland King and Queen Defenders of the faith etc Ammo Domini 1690
