

The following letter was photographed at Huntingdon Archives on 29th of Jan 2024 and relates to a transaction over land in Keyston between John Holden and William Gambo

24 Aprill 1731

I John Holden of Keyston in the County of Huntington do agree to attorn (to formally agree to become a tenant of a new property owner or landlord) Tennant to William Gambo of Wellingborough in the County of Northamptonshire for two certain closes in Keyston in the County of Huntington late in the occupation of Luke Greeney and late the estate of Robert Gambo of Bythorn in the County aforesaid and have paid the said William Gambo five pound which I declare to be in the name of and as part of rent witness my hand
