

The following letter was photographed at Huntingdon Archives on the 14th November 2014. And shows that the Reverend Binns managed to find some extra income via some ancient enclosures

Saturday May 3rd 1845

Mr Martin attended this Committee In Covington – The Reverend Cornelius Alphonso Binns also attended as did also Mr Parris on the part of The Duke of Manchester.

The Act and Award was produced, by which it appears that of several ancient enclosures enumerated in the award consisting 230 acres 3 roods 29 perches

Payment to the Rector as enumerated in the Award amounting to £1 pound 4 shillings and 2 pence payable annually at Michaelmas.

Mr Martin awarded that from the 1st of October the payment. of £1 4s 2d be continued subject to variations as in the Act
