

This map was photographed at Huntingdon Archives on the 6th August 2021 at the time it was available under a reference number but it has subsequently been digitalised as Keyston Map by Cosmo Wallace ID FSB3971 which is a little out of focus. The map has the Title – **A plan of the lands belonging to his grace George Montegu Duke and Earl of Manchester lying in the parish of Keystone and in the county of Huntingdon surveyed by Cosmo Wallace 1764.**

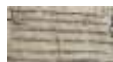
There are also a couple of keys the first shows who is currently renting each plot of land unfortunately due to the age of the map deciphering the colours allocated to individuals is not really possible., and the second has a key for some of the main elements on the plan again due to wear and tear they are not as clear as we would hope but I have assigned as best as possible

The Enclosures of Keystone, as they are presently occupied by the tenants, is separately circumscribed by different colours, and contains as follows.
